Below is a recent letter from Mission Church-supported missionary Karen DeVries. Karen ministers to children in the Missoula area, serving with BCM International.

Dear Mission Church Family,

I am back in my Bible Club teaching schedule; however, not as many children as pre-covid.

Monday: Hellgate elementary school, after 2 years of no one else in the school, including parents.

Tuesday: Target Range school. I was able to conduct this one last year, with masks and spacing for the part of the school year.

Thursday: Clinton school. This one used to be at noon time; couldn't do it this way anymore, so it's after school at 2:30 as it is an early release day. Also did it last year.

Friday: Franklin elementary which is one of the schools right in main Missoula. Only 3 kids! It is rebuilding time.

Once they finish 5th grade, they go to a middle school. So, during my 2-year absence, there were many who finished elementary.

I will be doing one on Wednesdays at my church, but the church office is requiring a proof of insurance certificate this year and that is taking a while. My BCM office takes care of it. When that comes, I will get the word out and get started there.

Due to the change in club scheduling, I have had to drop the DeSmet & Bonner schools.

Prayer requests: for protection of the Bible Clubs, for growth at the Franklin one, for the salvation and growth of all the kids. And that I will stay healthy. Had covid again in September.

Praise: the new superintendent at Hellgate was so warm and gracious to me at the open house where I had a table about Bible Club. The principal in the building where we meet told me she was so glad to have us back! She said the kids need it. Praise the Lord!

Thank you, church family, for your prayers and faithful financial support! God bless you all and the new pastor. I look forward to meeting him! So glad the Lord brought you a permanent pastor.
